ABOUT OUR PROJECT

Our team and I have made 120 kits that are filled with hygienic items, non-perishable foods, and clothing that'll be distributed quarterly throughout District 81 for students in need. Each quarter has different items in their kits. For example, our Winter Kits are filled with coats, gloves, a warm blanket, and hand warmers, while our Summer Kits are filled with sunscreen, cooling towels, a portable fan, and tank tops.

INSPIRATION

I've seen a few of my friends experience financial insecurity and housing problems due to parental issues. Their stories inspired me to take action, raise awareness, and provide practical support by packing quarterly kits filled with hygienic items and non-perishable foods.

RESEARCH

- Homeless population has risen 106%, 4.3% being youths
- 42,436 students has experienced homelessness in Washington state, 87% due to loss of custody from a parent and 7% have had to live in an unsheltered space like a car or in abandoned buildings

We are just waiting to deliver our last 60 kits (Spring and Summer), which will be delivered around February after all the Fall and Winter Kits are distributed!

PROGRESS OF OUR PROJECT

We’ve partnered with Rusanne Modeland at the HEART Program to help us distribute our 120 kits throughout District 81. This is meant to help students who are in critical need of resources and hopefully impacts them positively by giving them necessities. So far, our Fall and Winter kits have been delivered and Rusanne is currently trying to find individuals who needs them before we deliver our Spring and Summer kits.

After my term on the Youth Council, I’m hoping that this program will continue under the HEART program.
